Scheduled Emergency Alarm Test

Please be advised that a routine Emergency Alarm Test has been scheduled for:

Wednesday 5th November

The test will commence at 11am and will include a siren-like noise. There will be three short alarms, each lasting approximately 15 seconds, spread over a five-minute period.

Decommissioning Activity

Please be advised that, decommissioning works at the Point of Ayr Terminal and site preparation activity on the surrounding Colliery are ongoing.

As part of the decommissioning works temporary offices and welfare facilities (in the form of cabins) will be installed inside the Terminal boundary from:

Tuesday 4th November — Friday 21st November

During this period, you may notice an increase in vehicle movements (traffic) and associated noise as cabins are positioned using mechanical equipment.

All decommissioning activity will be carried out within the permitted working hours below:

Monday to Friday: 08:00 to 18:00 *

Saturday: 08:00 to 13:00 *

*** Please note that there will be one hour allocated to preparation and close down of site before and after the times outlined above.**
