Decommissioning and Construction Activity

Please be advised that decommissioning and construction works at the Point of Ayr Terminal are ongoing. As part of these works, there will be concrete pouring activities inside the Terminal boundary from

Monday 2nd February to Friday 6th February

The concrete will be poured inside the normal working hours (08:00-18:00), but finishing work activities will continue afterwards until midnight on two evenings during this week. You may notice an increase in lighting during this time, though noise will be kept to a minimum and no deliveries will occur.

Invasive Non-Native Plants Clearing Works

Please be advised that Cotoneaster clearing works will take place on the Colliery from

Monday 2nd February

During this time, the affected area will be fenced off to manage the invasive non-native plant.

Warren Farm Activity

Please be advised that there will be an increase in activity at Warren Farm from

Monday 2nd February

During this time, you may notice increased vehicle movements in and out of the area, with associated construction noise during working hours. These activities form part of the early PoA Cable Route Foreshore Works, which involve installing new electric and fibre-optic cables between the PoA Terminal and the New Douglas Offshore CCS Platform.
